Intermediate

Sizes:
7.5" wide x 29" (38") length

Materials:
 Cascade Yarns® Cascade 220®
 100% Peruvian Highland Wool
 100 g (3.5 oz) / 220 yd (200 m)
 2 skeins of #9322 (Silver Spruce Heather)
 US 8 (5.0 mm) knitting needles or size to obtain gauge
 Yarn Needle
 4 Buttons 7/8" (22 mm)
 Cable needle



Gauge:
 26 sts x 23 rows = 4" (10 cm) Blocked,
 in Celtic Cable & Rib Pattern

Note: *Be sure to make and block a gauge swatch. This is a very stretchy Stitch Pattern and will look much smaller before blocking.*

Abbreviations:

- BO = Bind Off
- BC = Back Cross: Slip next st to CN and hold at back, K1, then P1 from CN.
- BKC = Back Knit Cross: Slip next st to CN and hold at back, K1, then K1 from CN.
- CO = Cast On
- CN = Cable Needle
- FC = Front Cross: Slip next st to CN and hold at front, P1, then K1 from CN.
- FKC = Front Knit Cross: Slip next st to CN and hold at front, K1, then K1 from CN.
- K = Knit
- LH = Left Hand
- P = Purl
- RH = Right Hand
- Rnd(s) = Round(s)
- RS = Right Side
- St(s) = Stitch(es)
- WS = Wrong Side

Special Stitches:

MB (Make Buttonhole):

With yarn in front, sl next st purl-wise. Move yarn to back and leave it there, *[sl next st from LH needle. Pass the 1st slip st over it]; repeat from * 3 more times. Slip last BO st to LH needle. Turn work.

Use the Cable CO with the yarn at back as follows: *[Insert the RH needle between the 1st & 2nd sts on the LH needle, draw up a loop and place that loop on the LH needle]; repeat from * 4 more times. Turn work.

Slip the 1st st with the yarn at back from the LH needle. Pass the extra CO st over it to close the buttonhole.

1 x 1 Rib Pattern Stitch: (Multiples of 2)

Rnd 1: *[K1, P1]; repeat from * across.

Repeat Rnd 1 for Stitch Pattern.

Celtic Cable & Rib Pattern Stitch: (Multiples of 18 + 12)

Row 1 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2 (RS): P3, *[BKC, P2, BKC, P3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 3 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 4 (RS): P3, K2, P2, K2, *[P2, (BC, FC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Row 5 (WS): K3, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to last 9 sts, P2, K2, P2, K3.

Row 6 (RS): P3, K2, P2, K2, *[P2, K1, P2, FKC, P2, K1, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Row 7 (WS): K3, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to last 9 sts, P2, K2, P2, K3.

Row 8 (RS): P3, K2, P2, K2, *[P2, (FC, BC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Row 9 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 10 (RS): P3, K2, P2, K2, *[P3, BKC, P2, BKC, P3, K2, P2, K2]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Row 11 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 12 (RS): P3, K2, P2, K2, *[P2, (BC, FC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Row 13 (WS): K3, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to last 9 sts, P2, K2, P2, K3.

Row 14 (RS): P3, K2, P2, K2, *[P2, K1, P2, FKC, P2, K1, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Row 15 (WS): K3, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to last 9 sts, P2, K2, P2, K3.

Row 16 (RS): P3, K2, P2, K2, *[P2, (FC, BC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3.

Row 17 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 18 (RS): P3, *[BKC, P2, BKC, P3]; repeat from * to end of row

Row 19 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 20 (RS): *[P2, (BC, FC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 12 sts, P2, (BC, FC) twice, P2.

Row 21 (WS): K2, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 22 (RS): *[P2, K1, P2, FKC, P2, K1, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 12 sts, P2, K1, P2, FKC, P2, K1, P2.

Row 23 (WS): K2, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 24 (RS): *[P2, (FC, BC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 12 sts, P2, (FC, BC) twice, P2.

Row 25 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 26: P3, *[BKC, P2, BKC, P3, K2, P2, K2, P3]; repeat from * to last 9 sts, BKC, P2, BKC, P3.

Row 27 (WS): K3, *[P2, K2, P2, K3]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 28 (RS): *[P2, (BC, FC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 12 sts, P2, (BC, FC) twice, P2.

Row 29 (WS): K2, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 30 (RS): *[P2, K1, P2, FKC, P2, K1, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 12 sts, P2, K1, P2, FKC, P2, K1, P2.

Row 31 (WS): K2, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2, *[(P2, K2) twice, P1, K2, P2, K2, P1, K2]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 32 (RS): *[P2, (FC, BC) twice, (P2, K2) twice]; repeat from * to last 12 sts, P2, (FC, BC) twice, P2.

Repeat Rows 1 - 32 for st pattern.

Begin Pattern:

CO 48 sts.

Bottom Ribbing:

Row 1: *[P1, k1]; repeat from * to end of row.
Repeat Row 1 for 6 rows.

Scarf:

Work Celtic Cable & Rib Pattern for 4 (6) repeats, then repeat Rows 1 - 18 (Rows 1 - 20).

Top Ribbing:

Row 1: *[P1, K1]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2: *[P1, K1]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 3: *[P1, K1]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 4 (Buttonhole Row): P1, K1, P1, MB, *[(P1, K1) 2 more times, P1, MB] 3 times; repeat from * to last 4 sts, [P1, K1] twice.

Note: *Be sure that you end with 4 sts after making buttonholes.*

Row 5: *[P1, K1]; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 6: *[P1, K1]; repeat from * to end of row.

Finishing:

BO in 1 x1 Rib pattern.

Weave in all ends.

Block as necessary.

Sew on buttons.
